

1 INTRODUCTION

A lot of time spent in studios in Nashville and New York results in the songs released on **Self Portrait** and **New Morning**, and later on Columbia Records "revenge album" **Dylan**. Apart from the songs on **New Morning** these songs are covers. No live appearances are known from 1970, only the brief appearance in the TV program Earls Scruggs Documentary in December.

6 NEW MORNING

At least 195 takes of 50 songs during 8 recording sessions yielded the 12 songs on **New Morning**. 1 further song was released as a single and another 7 were later released on **Dylan**.
